Who We Are

Spectrum is a leading human services provider for persons with intellectual and developmental disabilities in Colorado. We strive to provide individuals with the greatest quality of life and the highest level of independence in the community.

What We Offer

Residential Services

Spectrum's Residential Services are available through the Home and Community-Based Services for Persons with Developmental Disabilities (HCBS-DD) waiver.

Our Family Caregiver and Independent Living Services allow individuals to live in their own homes and communities. However, when it is not possible to continue to support a person at home, we provide placement services with one of our prescreened and state-qualified Host Home Providers.

Behavioral Services

Spectrum understands that behavior is a form of communication.

Our LCSWs, BCBAs, and RBTs develop individualized plans based on professional assessments and provide innovative hands-on training to ensure every individual we serve feels heard and supported.

Day Services

We offer Day Services to individuals who receive the HCBS-DD waiver and Home and Community-Based Supported Living Services (HCBS-SLS) waiver.

Both waivers enable participants to maximize their goals and independence with the following programs provided by Spectrum.

Day Program & Spectrum Academy

At Spectrum's Day Program, individuals participate in activities at our Lakewood location and in the community, allowing them to remain active and develop social relationships outside their homes.

Spectrum Academy is a program designed for exceptional academic learning and growth for persons with intellectual and developmental disabilities.

Supported Employment

Spectrum recognizes that employment is a cornerstone of health and well-being for all people.

Our Supported Employment program is constructed in a series of phases designed to meet the occupational needs of a person:

- Job Prep & Development
- Job Coaching
- Job Maintenance

Supported Living Services

The HCBS-SLS waiver enables persons enrolled to make choices and live independently in an environment of their choosing with services from a Spectrum provider or their own family member.

Spectrum works with individuals and their families to develop and implement personal goals tailored to their home and community life.

We offer the following services through the HCBS-SLS waiver:

- Homemaker: enhanced & basic
- Respite: hourly & overnight
- Personal Care
- Mentorship
- Supported Community Connections: one-on-one & with Day Program
- Supported Employment
- Day Program

Children's Extensive Services

Spectrum provides services and supports to individuals under the age of 18 and their families.

Children who qualify for the Home and Community-Based Children's Extensive Services (HCBS-CES) waiver are eligible for the following services:

- Homemaker: enhanced & basic
- Respite: hourly & overnight
- Community Connector

All Spectrum staff are screened, state-qualified, and trained in CPR/FA and QMAP. Additional behavioral de-escalation courses will be provided when needed.
