Both Host Home Providers and Family Caregivers play a vital role in creating safe, supportive environments where individuals can grow and thrive. All caregivers are fully screened; receive ongoing training and competitive pay; and have access to additional support and oversight from a residential program coordinator, nurse, clinician and public benefits specialist.

Through the Family Caregiver Act, eligible families can receive financial and non-financial support with flexible options, including:
